Season Pass Terms & Conditions

Winter 2011 / 2012

General

- All age cut-offs are based on the date of purchase. Those turning 65 after the date of purchase, but prior to December 31st, 2011 may purchase their pass at the Senior Rate.
- All pass holders must sign a Release of Liability Waiver prior to receiving their season pass.
- If the pass holder is under the age of 19, the Release of Liability must be signed by a parent or legal guardian only.
- All pass holders must sign a Fraudulent Use Agreement prior to receiving your season pass.
- Season Passes are non-transferrable and may be revoked by Kicking Horse Mountain Resort Management or Ski Patrol for misuse or misconduct.
- Pass Holders must show photo ID or proof of age upon season pass pick-up
- Season Passes remain the property of Kicking Horse Mountain Resort Limited Partnership and are for recreational use only

Season Pass Payment Plan

- A Payment Plan is available on all Season Pass purchases made during the Early Bird Sales Dates.

Season Pass Refund Option

- The Refund Option must be purchased at the same time as the season pass.
- No credits or refunds will be given without the purchase of the Refund Option

Parent Pass

- A Parent Pass is one transferrable Season Pass, which may only be used by one parent at a time
- Both parents must be present at the time of purchase and/or pick-up
- Your child must be 6 years or under at the time of purchase
- A Birth Certificate must be presented upon purchase and/or pick-up
- The child's last name must be registered under the father or mother's last name; otherwise proof of legal guardianship is required.

Family Pass

- A family is defined as parents and/or children 18 years & under living at the same residence
- Proof of address must be provided for each family member
- Children 6 years & under do not count towards the Family Pass, and will be issued a Tot Season Pass
- Children 19 years & over do not count towards the Family Pass, must apply as a single adult or full-time student upgrade*if applicable

*Full-Time Student Upgrade

- Students (19 – 25 years) must be full-time at an accredited Canadian College or University
- Student ID or proof of full time enrolment must be presented at the time of purchase and/or pick-up
- The Student must be part of the immediate family, in the event the parent is not with the student, written documentation must be provided by the parent along with photocopied Photo ID to be cross referenced against the Family Pass of the parent.

Student Pass

- Students must be full-time at an accredited Canadian College or University
- Student ID or proof of full time enrolment must be presented at the time of purchase and/or pick-up

Midweek Pass

- Midweek Season Passes are valid Monday through Friday
- A discounted 1 day lift ticket will be available to Midweek Passes holders wishing to ski/ride at the resort on Saturdays & Sundays
